The following are driving directions to the City of New Bedford's Elm St. and Zeiterion Theatre parking garages, where there will be free parking to all Bioneers by the Bay attendees throughout the weekend. Maps to The Zeiterion Theatre will be provided at the garage. Parking on downtown streets will also be free throughout the conference.

FROM BOSTON

- Route 93 South (13 miles). Hwy. forks in Braintree; stay right. Sign reads: "93 South, Dedham-Providence." (3 miles)
- Exit 4: Route 24 South: This is a left lane exit (24 miles)
- Exit 12: Route 140 South (19 miles)
- Exit 2E: Interstate 195 East (1.3 miles)
- Exit 15: Downtown - Route 18 South (1.1 miles)

FROM CAPE COD

- Route 6 West
- Route 25
- Route I-195 West
- Exit 15: Downtown - Route 18 South

FROM PROVIDENCE, RI

- Route 95
- Route I-195 East
- Exit 15: Downtown - Route 18 South

FOR ELM STREET GARAGE

- TURN RIGHT at lights onto Elm Street
- The parking garage is two blocks on right

FOR ZEITERION THEATRE GARAGE

- TURN RIGHT at second set of lights onto Union Street. Travel four blocks.
- TURN LEFT onto Acushnet Ave. Parking garage is a block and a half on the right.
